On March 16th, Cathy Baldwin and Karen Pugh took 10 Comfort quilts to the Boca Raton Regional Hospital Infusion Center this month.

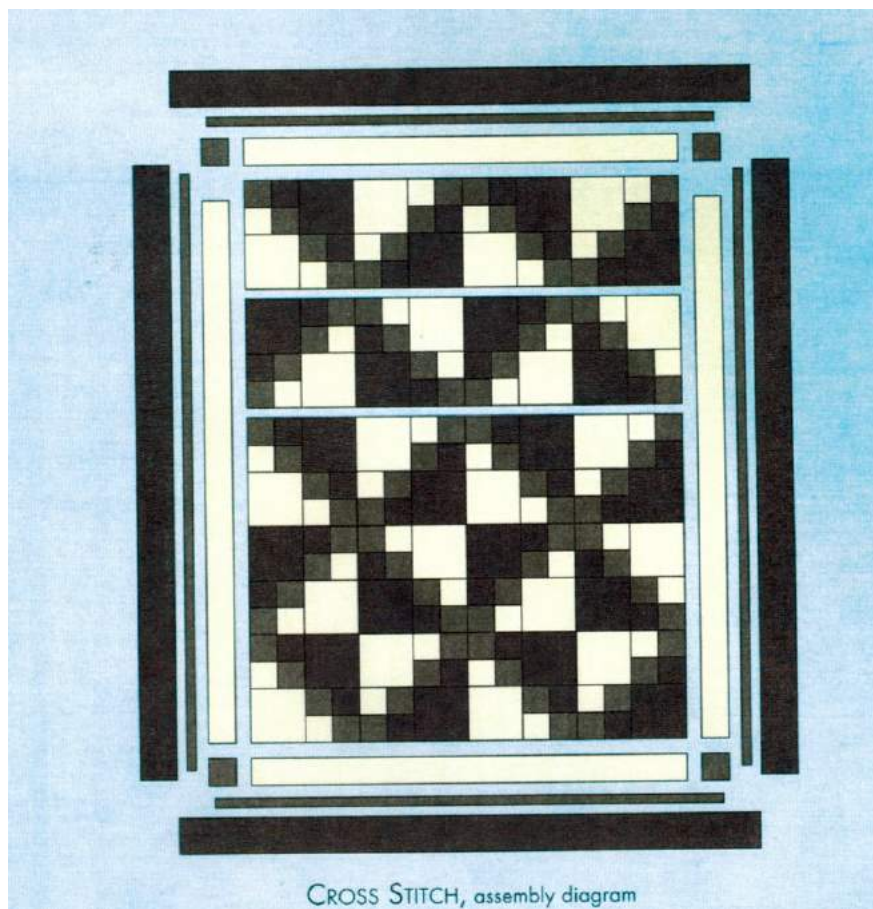

BORDER FABRIC IDs and FINISHING REQUIREMENTS

FABRIC ID	Yardage	Cut
Inner Border: Coordinate	3/4 yd.	6 strips, 3 1/2" x 40"
Middle Border: Contrast	3/8"	7 strips, 1 1/2" x 40"
Outer Border: Feature		7 strips, 4 1/2" x 40"
Cornerstones: Contrast	scraps	4 squares, 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
Batting	1 package twin size batting	
Backing	4 3/4 yd.	
Binding	2/3 yd.

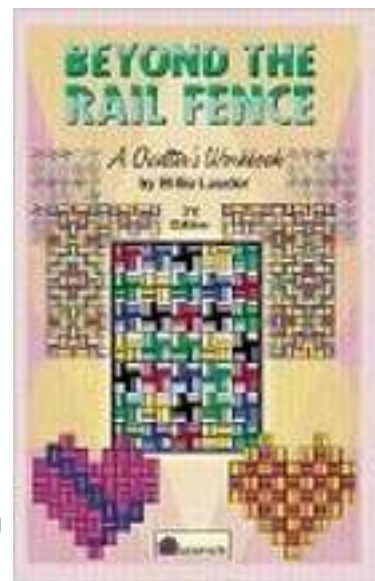

Beyond The Rail Fence by Billie Lauder

You have to love Billie Lauder. I got to learn about her wonderful quilting techniques when she was a frequent guest on the "Love of Quilting" TV show. Her methods are fast, clear and accurate. Although I have never made a Rail Fence quilt, this book could inspire me to sew one. A Rail Fence pattern is one of the easiest to put together, and it could be planned scrappy. This little book is packed with variations of design, color options, layouts, and charts. Keep this book by your side, and you'll find everything you need to know about making a Rail Fence quilt.

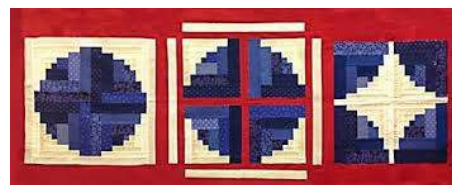
2016 QUILT CHALLENGE

Theme: "Log Cabin".

Challenge Guidelines:

The entry must:

- be any size up to and including 54" X 75". Nothing larger.
- include at least one complete log cabin (traditional or non-traditional/curved) block.
- use any quilting technique: pieced, appliqued, paper pieced, etc. Machine or hand quilted.
- have a 4" hanging sleeve on the back.
- have a label on the back right hand corner with your name, name of the person who did the quilting, the name of the quilt, and Quilt Guild by the Sea.
- be made and completed between December 1, 2015 and October 11, 2016. **NO Exceptions or Extensions.**

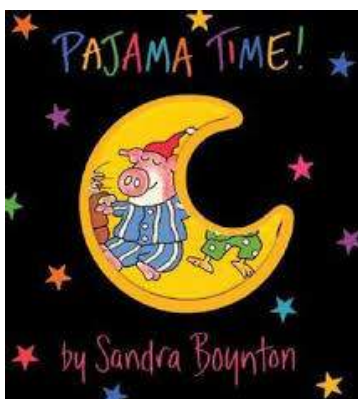
