


FAT QUARTER OF THE MONTH: KAFFE COLLECTIVE-TREE FUNGI




Size: No one side shorter than 12'' or larger than 24". Therefore, any size you wish between 12''x12'' and 24''x24'' and in any shape.

Theme: Make a small quilt featuring those amazing decorative stitches on your machine. Use as many different stitches as you can, with any assortment of threads (cotton, poly, trilobal, rayon, etc.) in any way you want. The finished piece must "read" as being all about decorative stitching.

Background: Can be one piece of solid, hand dyed or print fabric, or it can be pieced or appliqued. The background must be a supporting element for the main theme of decorative stitching.

Embellishments: Decorative stitches (the ones that are built into your machine). Couching techniques and use of rick-rack or other narrow trims (1/4"-3/8" wide) are permitted, but should not exceed more



than 5% of the total stitching. Free-motion quilting, machine embroidery and hand embroidery are not allowed.


Reference Material: This challenge is based on the ideas and artistry of quilter Carol Ann Waugh. Her book "Stupendous Stitching. How to Make Fun and Fabulous Fiber Art", is a goldmine of information. She also has a Blueprint (Craftsy) video that can be seen on YouTube and Google.

Challenge Due Date: General Meeting on Tuesday, November 10, 2020

Have fun with this challenge and learn a new technique.






