FAT QUARTER OF THE MONTH: CRINKLE STRIPE—SAPHIRE BLUE



Chevron stripes look like crinkled paper as light and dark hues of white, iris and lapis blue, lagoon and mallard

blue, water and lake blue, and sapphire and cobalt blue create an illusion of depth. A combination of three wide stripes, four medium stripes, and five skinny stripes stretch from edge to edge of the fabric. The wide chevron stripes are about 1". "Crinkle Stripe" from Andover Fabrics.



Two Hour Mini Quilt Projects

Ready for a quick, cute, and give-away-able project? Here is a book to get you started...from piecing, to applique, to embroidery, to stenciling.

Several designers have compiled lots of designs and patterns. All the basics are clearly explained to help you get started. I would probably never



stencil but could use the pattern for an applique. The designs are seasonal and interest related. The projects include ideas for gift items, practical things, and quilty things. I loved the bright photographs and very clear instruction. Each designer added her unique perspective and talent. This is a fun as well as a practical book.

2016 QUILT CHALLENGE

Theme: "Log Cabin".

Challenge Guidelines:

The entry must:

- be any size up to and including 54" X 75". Nothing larger.
- include at least one complete log cabin (traditional or non-traditional/curved) block.
- use any quilting technique: pieced, appliqued, paper pieced, etc.
 Machine or hand quilted.
- have a 4" hanging sleeve on the back.
- have a label on the back right hand corner with your name, name of the person who did the quilting, the name of the quilt, and Quilt Guild by the Sea.
- be made and completed between December 1, 2015 and October 11, 2016. **NO Exceptions or Extensions**.

A sign-up sheet will be available at the General Meeting.

The secret to a great mystery quilt is high contrast! I always pick my feature fabric first!


