




### FAT QUARTER OF THE MONTH: SAIL AWAY-LIGHTHOUSE STRIPE

Wide stripes bordered by nautical rope and maritime signal flags act as anchors for images of East Coast lighthouses. Behind the historic light-





### 2016 QUILT CHALLENGE

Theme: "Log Cabin".

**Challenge Guidelines:** 

### The entry must:



- be any size up to and including 54" X 75". Nothing larger.
- include at least one complete log cabin (traditional or nontraditional/curved) block.
- use any quilting technique: pieced, appliqued, paper pieced, etc. Machine or hand quilted.
- have a 4" hanging sleeve on the back.
- have a label on the back right hand corner with your name, name of the person who did the quilting, the name of the quilt, and Quilt Guild by the Sea.
- be made and completed between December 1, 2015 and October 11, 2016. **No Exceptions or Extensions**.

A sign-up sheet will be available at the General Meeting.

## New Quilts From an Old Favorite Contest, by Smith, AQS

This book offers three old favorites to the quilting community and offers many interpretations; some are modern, others more traditional. The patterns included in this book are Double Wedding Ring, Log Cabin, and Ohio Star. The results are both amazing and in-



spiring. Each quilt maker is an artist using color, form, shape, and imagination. This book is a treat for any quilter. It takes you into the thoughts, eyes, and hands of the person who transformed very old, traditional quilt pattern and took it light years away.




