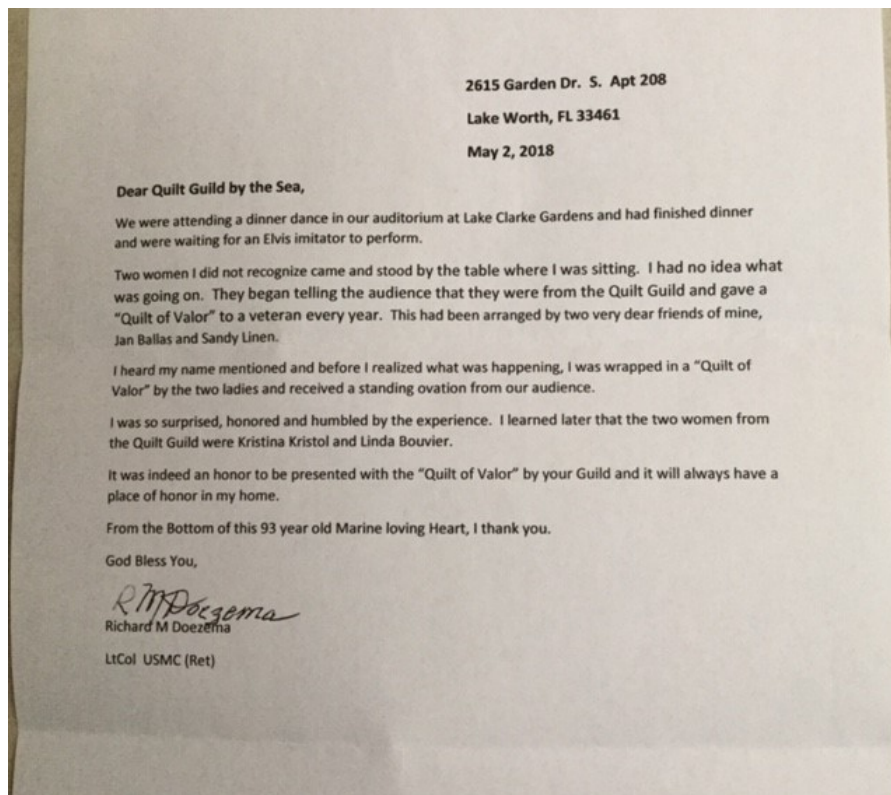

The pillow fits under the arm pit and eases the pain of lymph node surgery.

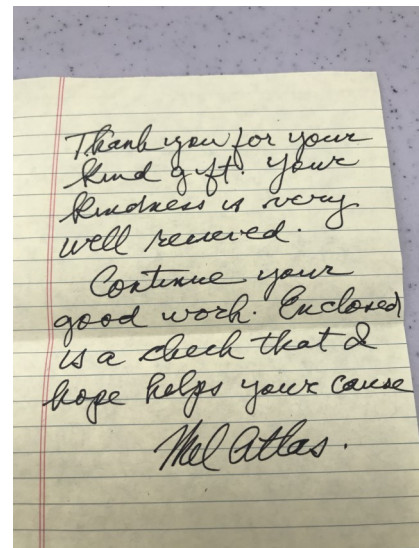

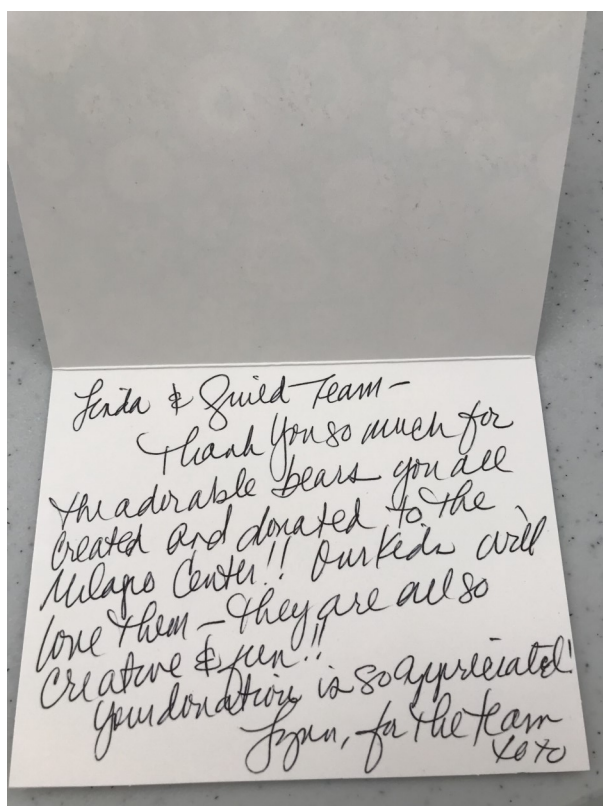
COMMUNITY OUTREACH

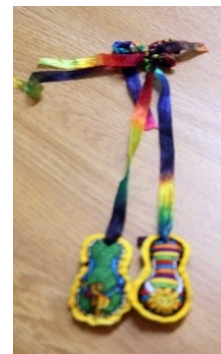

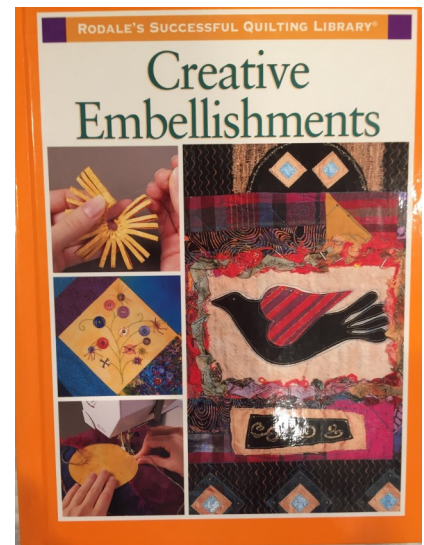
BOOK REVIEW:

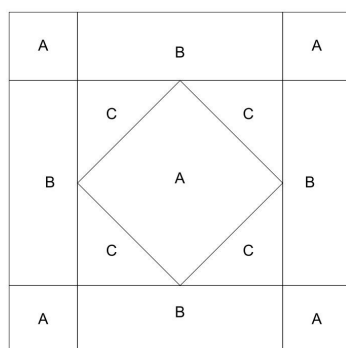
Quilts of Valor: Fair and Square

Block should measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2"



Sewing Instructions:

1. Draw diagonal line on the wrong side of four 3" squares.
2. To make the triangles place one 3" square on the corner of the 5 1/2" square with right sides together. Check diagram.
3. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim the fabric to 1/4". Press the seam to triangle.
4. Repeat on the other 3 corners of the large square. Press.
5. Using diagram sew one 3" square (corner) to one 3" x 5 1/2" to another 3" corner square.
6. Sew the remaining rectangles of the center from step 4.
7. Assemble the 3 rows together.

Cutting Instructions for Each Block:

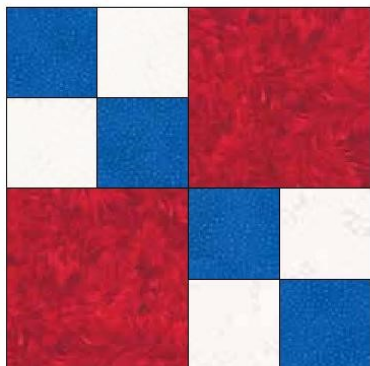
1. Use 100% cotton fabric.
2. Sew skimpy 1/4" seams to allow for the fabric lost in pressing.
3. Use patriotic colors to make the block. Background can be white, cream, tan or beige to coordinate with other fabrics.

Color A	Cut four squares 3" x 3" (corners)
Color A	Cut one square 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" (center)
Color B	Cut four rectangles 3" x 5 1/2"
Color C	Cut four squares 3" x 3" (triangles)



Quilts of Valor: Double Four Patch

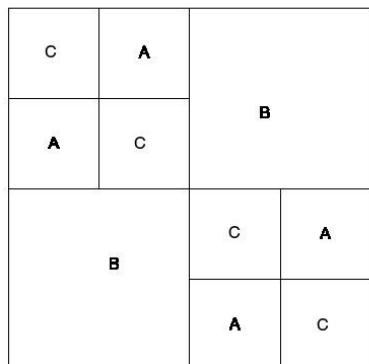
Block should measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2"



Sewing Instructions:

1. Sew one 3" block to 3" block of alternating color. Press to the dark.
2. Using diagram sew 2 patch into a 4 patch.
3. Sew one 5 1/2" square to one 4 patch.
4. Sew two rows together.

Cutting Instructions for Each Block:

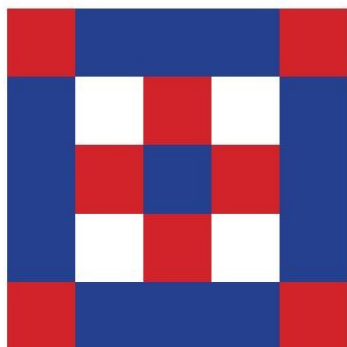
1. Use 100% cotton fabric.
2. Sew skimpy 1/4" seams to allow for the fabric lost in pressing.
3. Use patriotic colors to make the block. Background can be white, cream, tan or beige to coordinate with other fabrics.

Cut four squares 3" x 3" (white)	A
Cut two squares 5 1/2" x 5 1/2"	B
Cut four squares 3" x 3" (blue)	C



Quilts of Valor: Framed Nine Patch

Block should measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2"



Sewing Instructions:

1. Using diagram to sew the center, sew a nine patch using 2 1/2" squares.
2. Sew one 2 1/2" X 6 1/2" rectangle to two sides of center.
3. Sew corner to side 2 1/2" X 6 1/2" rectangle for top and bottom.
4. Sew three rows together.

Cutting Instructions for Each Block:

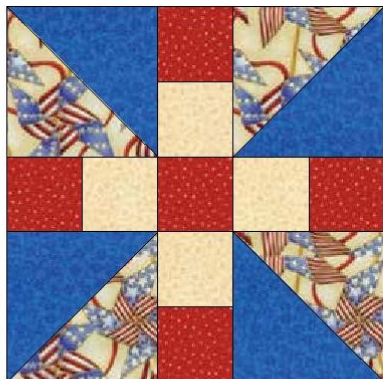
1. Use 100% cotton fabric.
2. Sew skimpy 1/4" seams to allow for the fabric lost in pressing.

Color A	Cut eight 2 1/2" squares
Color B	Cut four 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
Color B	Cut one 2 1/2" square
Color C	Cut four 2 1/2" squares



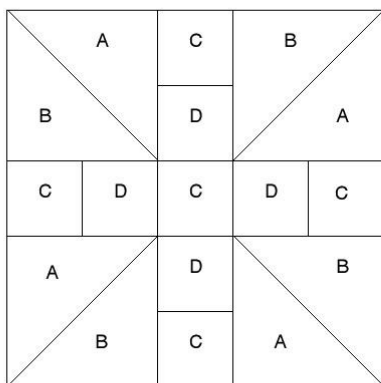
Quilts of Valor: Whirly Girly

Block should measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2"



Sewing Instructions:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the two light 4 7/8" squares.
2. Place each of those light squares right sides together with the other two 4 7/8" squares. Sew 1/4" inch on each side of drawn line. Cut on drawn line. Press seam to dark.
3. Sew a C square to a D square making four rectangle units.
4. Using diagram sew squares and rectangles together.

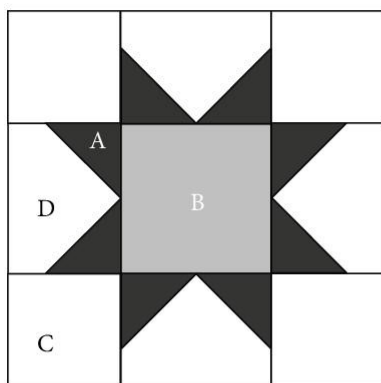
Cutting Instructions for Each Block:

1. Use 100% cotton fabric.
2. Sew skimpy 1/4" seams to allow for the fabric lost in pressing.
3. Use patriotic colors to make the block. Background can be white, cream, tan or beige to coordinate with other fabrics.

Color A	Cut two 4 7/8" squares
Color B	Cut two 4 7/8" squares
Color C	Cut five 2 1/2" squares
Color D	Cut four 2 1/2" squares

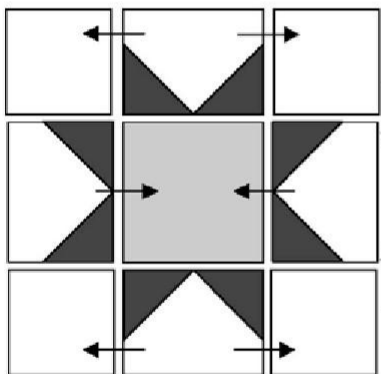
Quilts of Valor: Sawtooth Star

Block should measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2"



Sewing Instructions:

1. On A (Star Points) draw a diagonal line on the back of each. Place A at the left end of D (Background Side) right sides together. Stitch on drawn line. Trim seam to 1/4". Press triangle toward the corner. Place second star point on the right side of D. Repeat directions. Units should measure 3 1/2" x 4 1/2". Repeat to make four.



2. Lay out units and remaining pieces as in drawing at right. Sew units together in rows, pressing seams as indicated by arrows inside block diagram. Sew rows together and press away from center row as shown with arrows beside block. Trim to straighten the edges if needed. Must be 10 1/2" inches square.

Cutting Instructions for Each Block:

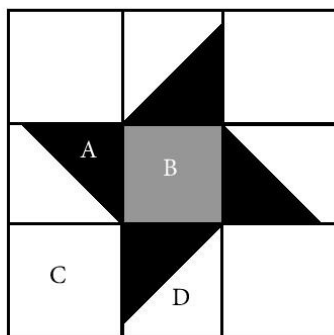
1. Use 100% cotton fabric.
2. Sew skimpy 1/4" seams to allow for the fabric lost in pressing.
3. Use patriotic colors to make the block. Background can be white, cream, tan or beige to coordinate with other fabrics.

Star Points	Cut eight squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"	A
Center Square	Cut one square 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"	B
Background - Corners	Cut four squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	C
Background - Sides	Cut four rectangles 3 1/2" x 4 1/2"	D



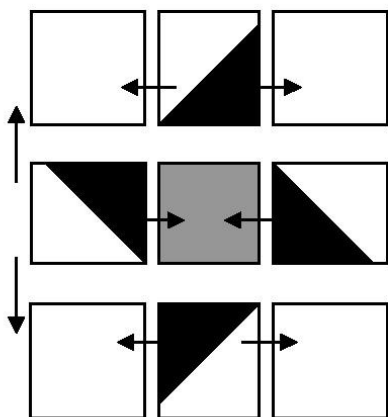
Quilts of Valor: Friendship Star

Block should measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2"



Sewing Instructions:

- Using A and D, place A at right end of D. Sew diagonally from corner to corner as in diagram at right. Be sure to sew them all at the angle shown. Press toward corner to make triangle. Trim excess to leave 1/4" seam allowance. Unit should measure 3 1/2" x 4". Repeat to make four.



- Lay out units and remaining pieces as in drawing at left. Sew units together in rows, pressing seams as indicated by arrows inside block diagram. Sew rows together and press away from center row as shown with arrows beside block. Trim to straighten the edges if needed.

Time to make another??

- Use 100% cotton fabric.
- Sew skimpy 1/4" seams to allow for the fabric lost in pressing.

**RECOMMENDED PACKAGING FOR
SHIPMENT**

Place fabric bag into plastic bag and then in a sturdy reusable carton. Use strapping tape to close. Your entry will be returned in the same carton. If we are to ship the entry after the show, enclose a pre-addressed return label and check payable to PBCQG for return shipping and insurance. Place this information in an envelope inside the carton.

INSURANCE

Insurance coverage will be provided while items are in the possession of the Guild. The maximum limit for insurance coverage is \$300 for small quilts, and \$600 for large quilts unless a copy of a certified appraisal of a higher value is presented with the registration form.

CATEGORIES

LP - Large pieced. Entirely pieced. Width plus length must be greater than 120 inches.

SP - Small pieced. Entirely pieced. Width plus length must be 120 inches or less

A - Applique. Majority of quilt must be applique techniques. Any Size from 120 inches to king size

MO - Modern. Quilt should embody principles of modern design with bold color, contrast, graphic areas of color, negative space etc. May be a single maker, duo or group effort.

ML - Miniature. Any technique. Must be a miniaturization of a full quilt design, including binding. Width plus length must be no greater than 40 inches. No single blocks.

DL - Duet Large. A quilt that has two persons involved in its completion. Includes all techniques as well as quilting by a person other than the maker of the top. Must be greater than 280" width plus length.

DS- DUET SMALL. A quilt made by two persons with width plus length between 96" and 280".

A - Art. Original design - any techniques, any size. Must be made of fabric, have three layers, and contain quilting. A quilt based on traditional patterns and designs should be entered in another category. No commercial patterns, kits, or copies of previous works.

E-EXHIBIT ONLY. Whole cloth, crazy quilts, embroidery of all kinds (hand and machine) antique, all sizes. Exhibit only and appropriate for hanging. No Kit Quilts, Tied Quilts, Yo-Yo, Cathedral Window, Home Dec (Pillows, Table Runners, etc.)

AWARDS

Ribbons and cash awards of \$75, \$50, and \$25 for First, Second and Third place in all categories. Each prize will be awarded at the judge's discretion. Not all prizes in all categories may be awarded. Ribbons will be awarded for Honorable Mentions.

The Best of Show will receive \$100.00. Ribbons and \$25 cash will be awarded for Best Hand Quilting, Best Machine Quilting, Judge's Choice, and Viewers' Choice.

RULES

(1) Any individual or group may enter. All persons involved in the construction or quilting must be listed on the entry form.

(2) There is a limit of two entries per category per person or group for judged quilts. A separate entry form and photo is required for each entry. Form may be photocopied. Entry fees: **\$15.00 for judging as a non-member, \$10 for our Guild members and \$8.00 for exhibit only.**

(3) A non-returnable color photograph of the item must accompany each entry form for purposes of identification and insurance.

(4) Entries **must** remain on display for the duration of the show 4:00pm October 13, 2018

(5) Each entry must have a label on the lower back right hand corner with the maker/owner's name and address. The label **must** be covered with a removable piece of fabric for judging.

(6) Each entry **must** have a four (4) inch wide sleeve stitched to the top of the quilt except miniatures which must have a two (2) inch wide sleeve. This sleeve must be attached on both top and bottom edges of the sleeve. Bed-sized quilts must have an additional sleeve, the top of which must be attached 85" from the bottom edge of the quilt so that the quilt will not touch the floor. Sleeve **must** be attached in a way that it will not show when the quilt is hanging.

(7) Each entry **must** be enclosed in a separate fabric bag or pillowcase with the entrant's name clearly written on the bag. **No Plastic bags please.**

(8) Quilts must be clean and in excellent condition. **(9)** Quilt size (width and length) **must** be listed on entry form. Accurate measurements are a must.

(10) All judged quilts must have been made within the last five years.

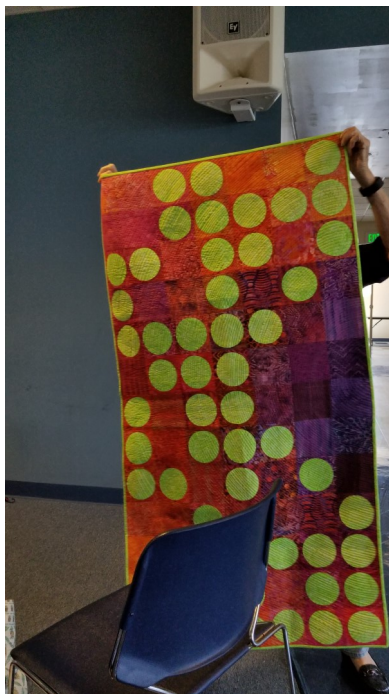

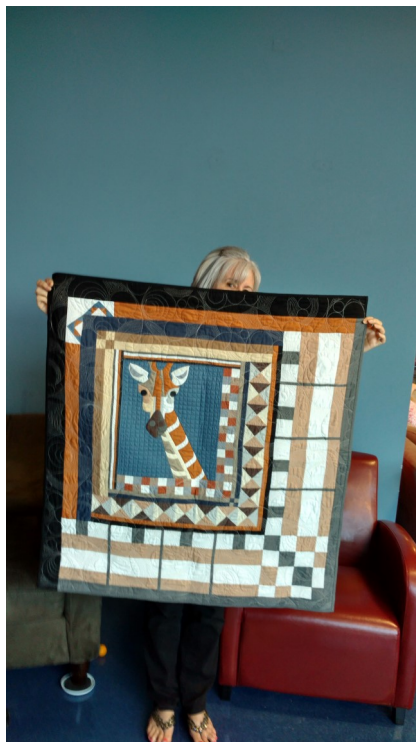
