# Mystery Quilt Cutting and Sewing Directions

Section III
Cutting Directions for Section III:
From Light Background Fabric cut (10)
$11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips into (38) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (D)
From Dark Background Fabric cut (1)
$1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strip into (15) $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 1 \frac{112 "}{}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares (E).

## Sewing Directions for Section III:

Make 6 rows, join 4 blocks together with a $11 / 2$ " $\times 9$ " sashing strip (D) between the blocks, turning every other block so that the dark strips face in opposite directions, as shown. Alternate the position of the blocks on every other row. Press seams toward blocks.


Make (5) sashing rows, joining (4) $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ light background rectangles (D) and (3) $1 \frac{1 / 2 " 1}{} \times 1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ dark squares (E). Press seams towards squares.


Make 5


Sew the block and sashing rows together. Four blocks across and six blocks down. The quilt top, at this point, will measure approximately. $371 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 561 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
