

- Speedy recovery to Joyce Beckman's husband, who had cardiac by-pass surgery.











Build -A-Quilt Instructions 5-8

Message in the Needlework



Clue 5. Make 20.



Clue 6. Row X: Make 3.



Clue 7. Row Y: Make 2.

*Clue 5 1. Gather all of the A and B units completed in clues 3 and 4. 2. Join one of each unit as shown. Pay close attention to the positions of the large feature and coordinate squares. Press the seam allowances in any direction.

*Clue 6 1. Gather 12 blocks completed in clue 5. 2. Assemble three rows of blocks as shown. Pay close attention to the position of each large feature square in each row. Also make sure the contrast blocks step up in the correct direction. Press the seam allowances toward the feature squares. This is row X.

*Clue 7 1. Gather the remaining eight blocks completed in clue 5. 2. Assemble two rows of blocks as shown. Pay close attention to the position of each large feature square in the row. Also make sure the contrast blocks step down in the correct direction. Press the seam allowances toward the feature squares. This is row Y.

*Clue 8 1. Lay out the X and Y rows, alternating the rows, beginning and ending with an X row. Sew the rows together and press well. 2. Examine the solutions on pages 62–91 to find the quilt photo and assembly diagram that match your completed quilt top. Add the borders and finish your quilt as described in your quilt's solution page.



BOOK REVIEW:

10-20-30 Minutes to Quilt By Nancy Zeiman

I have often heard so many of my quilting buddies complain they don't have time to start on work on big projects. Sewing and/or quilting can be a daunting task, but if the right tactics can be used maybe we can accomplish a bit more and have some fun. From my observation, quilting is about fun. Nancy



Zeiman is a practical person. She shows us how we can use our time well, even if its in small bits. She has many interesting and doable projects using simple techniques, available materials, and good results. Although this is not her latest book, it offers instructions for working with fabric panels, fleece, photographs, and uncomplicated patch work. She has suggestions for gifts, décor, and holidays. Included are all the basics of quilting and sewing a novice might need. This book answers many of our current questions.

2016 QUILT CHALLENGE

Theme: "Log Cabin".

Challenge Guidelines:

The entry must:

- be any size up to and including 54" X 75". Nothing larger.
- include at least one complete log cabin (traditional or nontraditional/curved) block.
- use any quilting technique: pieced, appliqued, paper pieced, etc.
 Machine or hand quilted.
- have a 4" hanging sleeve on the back.
- have a label on the back right hand corner with your name, name of the person who did the quilting, the name of the quilt, and Quilt Guild by the Sea.
- be made and completed between December 1, 2015 and October 11, 2016. **NO Exceptions or Extensions**.

A sign-up sheet will be available at the General Meeting.

Create a portrait pattern using Amy Bradley's "Quilter's Yearbook" (a digital pattern) or use a yearbook pattern drawn by Dorothy. Use the pattern to make a raw-edge appliqué quilt. Learn how to quilt it with feed dogs up or down. Purchase of the 35 page "Quilter's Yearbook" pattern is required - \$5 for the digital file or \$10 for a paper copy.


