Many of our quilts are created with our dreams and imagination.


March is a month with many holidays.

She has designed over 100 fabric collections, both quilting cotton and batiks and is known for her innovative designs. She currently designs for Banyan Batiks, a division of Northcott.

Karen has appeared on many quilting TV programs and has a Craftsy class, New Directions in Tumbling blocks.

She has worked with Quilt Seminars at Sea for over a decade, teaching her quilting techniques and traveling the world.

#### **COMFORT QUILT NEWS:**

SAVE THE DATE:

On April 17, 2024 an Outreach workshop will be held at the Boca Raton Community Center from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM.

- The current quilt count YTD is at 49.
- Twenty-five quilts and 12 hats were delivered to Lynn Cancer Center in February.
- Twenty-five Comfort quilts were delivered to Delray Beach Rehabilitation and Trauma units in February.
- In addition, fifty Comfort quilts and Pillow Pals were delivered to Amy Chiera for Nick's Camp; our goal is 100 quilts.
- NICU quilts are always needed and much appreciated.
   Men's and teenage boy/boy Comfort quilts.



#### Comfort quilt size specifications are:

- Juvenile Comfort Quilts are needed in Trauma Centers. Crib size is suggested.
- Teenage and Tween Comfort Quilts are needed. The size should be approximately 40" X 70" in bright colors, geometric or modern prints, sport prints, or denim fabrics.
- The Guild has some batting available.
- Novelty and juvenile fabrics are needed as well as 2 yard measures of fabric for backings.
- A maximum of 40" wide, and a minimum of 48 54" in length.
- **NOTE:** Quilt tops should be 40" wide so that we can use one width of fabric and do not have to piece the backs. If you are using your own backing and batting and are doing your own quilting, feel free to make them wider and/or longer.
- The size of the NICU coverlets quilts is 36" X 36".
- We need domestic machine quilters to help us get our quilt tops finished! Feel free to practice your quilting or quilt simple straight lines. Take the time and opportunity to quilt your Comfort quilts on your machine; practice, hone your skills, and try new techniques and patterns. The final product does not have to be perfect.
- Longarmers are needed to quilt Comfort Quilts. If you would like to volunteer your skills, please contact Linda Eddy.




