NEW! EXCITING! THE 2022 QUILT CHALLENGE



Clint Eastwood's famous quote as "Dirty Harry" leads us into our 2022 Challenge.

WHAT IS IT THAT WOULD "MAKE YOUR DAY"?

NEWS FLASH! New Quilt Shop Coming to Boca


Laura's Sewing & Fabric will be opening their third store here in Boca sometime in September.

COMFORT QUILTS

- To date, we have received 107 fully quilted Comfort Quilts; 56 adult quilts, 25 children's quilts, and 25 NICU quilts. An additional 50 quilts were received unquilted.
- Don't forget, the Guild will provide batting!
- Needed: Men's and teenage boy/boy Comfort quilts.
- Juvenile Comfort Quilts are needed in Trauma Centers.
 Crib size is suggested.
- Novelty and juvenile fabrics are needed as well as 2 yard measures of fabric for backings.



- A maximum of 40"
 wide, and a minimum of 48 - 54" in length.
- NOTE: Quilt tops should be 40" wide so that we can use one width of fabric and do not have to piece the backs. If you are using your own backing and batting and are doing your own quilting, feel free to make them wider and/or longer.


