PRESIDENT'S LETTER:

Quilt raffles have long been a popular method of fund-raising by non-profit groups such as QGbtS. The term 'Donation Quilt' is what we now call our raffle quilt. Raffles are regulated by the state, and the change in terminology was necessary for compliance with current law.

QGbtS now produces two such quilts per year. One, referred to as the 'Church Quilt,' is gifted annually to our host facility as a thank you for allowing QGbtS to conduct meetings and other activities on its premises. All members of QGbtS are invited to participate in the construction of this quilt, and all the proceeds from its sale are retained by the Church. This project has been ongoing since almost our beginning.

The other Donation Quilt effort is only in its second year. In response to a need for additional funds with which to operate QGbtS, a small group of volunteers offered to make a quilt which could be raffled at the Mancuso, and other local shows. You may recall that the quilt was given a prominent spot at the Mancuso show and the quilt won a First Place and Best of Show awards at another show. It went on to net more than two thousand dollars for QGbtS's treasury, an amazing accomplishment considering that the average raffle quilt nets only hundreds of dollars.

Granted, some of our sister guilds also net big bucks but they have built into their dues dedicated dollars for this purpose. QGbtS does not. We depend solely on the sale of tickets to members and also by members to others outside our group, and you did a great job.

Another means of support by members is participation at shows by manning the booth and doing White Glove service when required. Many hands make light work, as the saying goes. All help is greatly appreciated, and in the end, we all benefit, in many ways.

If you will be attending either or both of the shows in Orlando and Daytona, please try to carve out some time to assist with ticket sales, if only an hour. A few members will be devoting many hours to this effort, but they too must eat and answer nature's call.

At the Mancuso Orlando show in January, QGbtS will be exhibiting its Donation Quilt, the 'Circle' challenge quilts, and the Build-a-Quilt entries. Congratulations and thanks to all who participated in these activities.

- may use any quilting technique: pieced, appliqued, paper pieced, etc. Machine or hand quilted.
- must have a 4" hanging sleeve on the back.
- must have a label on the back right hand corner with your name, name of the person who did the quilting, the name of the quilt, and Quilt Guild by the Sea.
- must be made between October 13, 2015 and October 11, 2016.










FAT QUARTER OF THE MONTH: Fallscapes—Old Mill Stream, 24" X 44 Panel


RED DOOR PROJECT UPDATE
