Pearl McIntyre , Auxiliary President of American Legion Post 162 graciously hosted the Quilts of Valor presentation on September 24, 2015.








All of this has been compiled to raise money for breast cancer research. All profits and donations have gone to this effort. The various quilts include piecing, appliqué and recipes. I sug-
