

VOTE ON REVISIONS TO BY-LAWS

The Board appoints a committee annually to review and update the Guild's By-Laws and Policies and Procedures. This is to ensure that these guidelines reflect how we conduct meetings and business as we adapt to changing times. Any changes to our By-Laws must be voted on by the membership.

Most of the changes were simply to improve or clarify wording, but two revisions bear highlighting.

Article III, Item 2 updates how General Meetings are conducted. The new wording states: "Monthly Guild meetings shall be held on the second Tuesday of each month. Meetings will either be hybrid (allowing in-person and virtual attendees), virtual only or in-person only, as circumstances dictate. Meetings with in-person attendance will be held at Boca Raton Community Center".

Article IV, Item 3.c. corrects how the Guild holds elections. The current By-Law starts by stating "The election shall be by ballot..." QGBTS has always been a paperless Guild and has never held an election by ballot. It is thought the wording was picked up from another guild's By-Laws when QGBTS was being established. The new wording reflects how we actually hold elections. It states, "The election of officers will be by affirmative vote of a majority of members present."

Members will receive a separate email containing the complete By-Laws and Policies and Procedures. Membership votes only on By-Laws changes. Please review them prior to our Annual Business Meeting. Many thanks.

Tina Craig started quilting in 1990. When we moved to a seaside town in southern Rhode Island in 1997, Seaside Stitches was born. Back then, I was making and selling hundreds of paper-pieced quilt block lapel pins. Now, I prefer to teach you how to make your own! I specialize in precision piecing (foundation paper piecing and English paper piecing) and domestic machine quilting.

Take a look beyond Grandmother's Flower Garden to see all the possibilities of EPP. From different shapes and sizes to improv and 3-dimensional projects, this trunk show may inspire a myriad of design options for your next quilt.

My trunk shows are engaging and fun. Every quilt I show has a story to tell.

I have been honored to have won awards in local and regional shows including Best of Show at Ninigret Quilters 2013, 2017 and Narragansett Bay Quilters Assoc 2016. My work has also been exhibited at Mid-Atlantic Quilt Festival, World Quilt New England, and QuiltCon Together 2021.


Program: Paula Golden presents Hawaiian Quilt Making

We will be having an Outreach Workshop and Exchange on Wednesday, November 15, from 10:00 AM-3:00 PM. Please mark your calendars and hold this date for a fun day of sewing!

As always, please feel free to work on the Comfort Quilt, Fidget, or Bear project that you prefer. Knitted items, pillow cases, or pillow pals are great to work on as well. Bring what you are already working on or pick up a new project. We will have kits and extra fabric to work with available.

The COMFORT QUILT special project for the day will be PIN BASTING and MACHINE WALKING FOOT QUILTING demos. We will have lots of quilt tops, batting and backings available so the basting table will be going strong all day long!

This was being done at Camp in August and many of us were surprised at how easy and quick this process is so we hope you enjoy and find the demos helpful.

The FIDGET special project for the day will be "Placemat Fidgets". Placemats make your project so easy; you have the base fabric already made, and you only need to add "Ellen's Junk" to finish a Fidget! There will be lots of finished samples to show.

Please bring any unwanted placemats to donate. We NEED Fidgets!

The BEARS will have beautiful Faces available as well all the other fabric and stuffing needed! Pillow Pal kits will also be available.

Ladies preferring to do handwork, who do not want to bring a machine, can be helpful at the Comfort Quilt basting table either pinning or ironing, and Fidgets can be sewn by hand as well! (bring your hand sewing supplies)

The Guild's Comfort Quilt participants have remained very productive; we are continuing to exceed our expectations.

Maureen, Pat and Linda delivered Comforts Quilts to Delray Medical Trauma and Pinecrest Rehab on Tuesday, October 3. Many thanks to all those who make our visits so joyful and create such great photos and memories for us to take back to our Quilters. It is always wonderful for us to see and hear how loved our quilts really are by the patients who are all recovering from such challenges. Keep making those quilts, ladies of Quilt Guild by the Sea! There is so much need out there for the comfort they provide.

The quilt total to date is a whopping 438 (211 adult, 174 teen/children, 53 NICU)!

Comfort Quilt ladies, you are truly as generous as you are talented. Each of these quilts is a work of art and bound to brighten someone's day. They are on their way to delivery. Thank you!

Needed: Men's and teenage boy/boy Comfort quilts.

- NICU quilts are always needed and much appreciated.
- Juvenile Comfort Quilts are needed in Trauma Centers. Crib size is suggested.
- Teenage and Tween Comfort Quilts are needed. The size should be approximately 40" X 70" in bright colors, geometric or modern prints, sport prints, or denim fabrics.
- The Guild has some batting available.
- Novelty and juvenile fabrics are needed as well as 2 yard measures of fabric for backings.

Comfort quilt size specifications are:

- ◆ A maximum of 40" wide, and a minimum of 48 54" in length.
- ♦ **NOTE:** Quilt tops should be 40" wide so that we can use one width of fabric and do not have to piece the backs. If you are using your own backing and batting and are doing your own quilting, feel free to make them wider and/or longer.
- The size of the NICU coverlets quilts is 36" X 36".
- We need domestic machine quilters to help us get our quilt tops finished! Feel free to practice your quilting or quilt simple straight lines. Take the time and opportunity to quilt your Comfort quilts on your machine; practice, hone your skills, and try new techniques and patterns. The final product does not have to be perfect.
- Longarmers are needed to quilt Comfort Quilts. If you would like to volunteer your skills, please contact Linda Eddy.
















































FIDGET QUILTS:




